## STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

**NEAN/NSBA Code: EEA** 

The Board will provide transportation for all students living beyond a reasonable distance from the school or from a scheduled bus stop.

## 1. Distances

- 1.1. Students in Grades K-2 shall be bused from a designated bus stop without regard to distance when deemed appropriate for safety purposes.
- 1.2. Students in Grades 3 through 12 may be required to furnish their own transportation up to one (1) mile from school or up to one half (1/2) mile to a designated bus stop.
- 1.3. Exceptions to walking distances may be made for students with disabilities as required by their IEP or 504 Plan or with written documentation from the students physician as to need.

## 2. Bus Stops

- 2.1 Authorized bus stops will be located so as to load and unload students with the most safety allowed by road condition.
- 2.2 The distance between stops may vary according to safety factors.
- 2.3 When and if possible, students will load and unload so that it will not be necessary for them to cross a main highway.

## 3. Guidelines

- 3.1 No school bus shall be required to travel other than on public roads.
- 3.2 Regulations necessary for the bus driver such as routing, emergency procedures and control of students while entering, riding or leaving a bus shall be determined by the principal, with consultation with the Director of Transportation, and made known to parents/guardians and students. Students failing to meet behavioral guidelines when loading, unloading or riding the bus shall be subject to disciplinary action as outlined in Board Policy JICC: Student Conduct on School Bus.
