The weighted grade(s) will also be reflected on the student's transcript and report card.

Any student who enrolls in and successfully completes a course from an accredited college or university in which the student is awarded full credit will have his or her grade in that course multiplied by a weighted factor of 1.08 for the purpose of creating a weighted Grade Point Average (GPA) used to determine class standing. The weighted grade(s) will also be reflected on the student's transcript and report card.
