Platforms for Public Information

Website Shawn Russell

rangeleyschool.org is RLRS' website. This website contains messaging for the public, students, and staff to see.

Shawn Russell handles all updates to information on the website, as directed or approved by RLRS Administration.

This platform holds information related to events, public announcements, public athletic information, public academic information, recognitions, as well as cancellations.

Facebook Wendy Steward

RLRS has a <u>Facebook page</u> under the title of Rangeley Lakes Regional School.

<u>Wendy Steward</u> manages all updates to this page, as directed by RLRS Administration. Updates include events, cancellations, and recognitions.

YouTube Shawn Russell

RLRS has two YouTube channels. One is titled <u>Rangeley Lakes</u> <u>Regional School,</u> the other is titled <u>Rangeley Technology.</u>

Shawn Russell manages all live-steams and videos to both channels.

Content on the <u>RLRS channel</u> includes academic events such as graduations, recognitions, and at times, guest speakers. Content on the <u>RLRS channel</u> also includes athletic events and school board meetings. Content on <u>Rangeley Technology</u> contains technology tips.

Platforms for Parent & Guardian Information



<u>Remind</u> is an SMS (text messaging) tool that RLRS' front office staff uses to communicate with parents, guardians, and staff.

Kim Dolbier handles the <u>Remind</u> platform. This includes the sending of messages, as well as the management of users on the platform. Kim Dolbier sends messages as directed by RLRS Administration.

As <u>Remind</u> is used exclusively for parents, guardians, and staff, messaging on this platform is geared to that audience.

Email Kim Dolbier

At RLRS, we use <u>Gmail</u> as our email service provider. All staff and students in grades 6-12 are provided a <u>GSuite</u> account with access to Gmail.

Kim Dolbier holds parent and guardian email addresses.

Kim Dolbier sends external information via email to appropriate audiences as directed by RLRS Administration.

<u>Seesaw</u>

Classroom Teachers & Shawn Russell

For students in grades Pre-K-5 at RLRS, we use <u>Seesaw</u> as our Learning Management System.

Every student in grades Pre-K-5 is rostered in their respective class in <u>Seesaw</u>, and the Seesaw app is installed on all iPads for students grades in K-5. This allows students post pictures of their work and perform work on assignments that are posted in Seesaw.

Parents and guardians connect to <u>Seesaw</u> via an email or QR code invitation. They can then either download the app, or receive updates via email or on the website.

Google Classroom 6-12 Classroom Teachers

For students in grades 6-12 at RLRS, we use <u>Google Classroom</u> as our Learning Management System.

Every student in grades 6-12 is provided a GSuite account by **Shawn Russell**, the GSuite Administrator for RLRS. This allows students to communicate in and work with the applications in the GSuite enterprise. Students in these grades also take their provided MacBook Airs home with them.

One of the applications in the GSuite is Google Classroom. Many of the classes in grades 6-12 at RLRS use <u>Google Classroom.</u> Parents can opt into these classes by providing their email address to the teacher.

PowerSchool Abigail Thompson

At RLRS, we use <u>PowerSchool</u> as our Student Information System.

Abigail Thompson manages all <u>PowerSchool</u> credentialing and information that is stored.

<u>PowerSchool</u> holds all of the information we have for students, including addresses, parent contact information, and much more.

<u>PowerSchool</u> also holds information on student progress and grades.

Parents and guardians are able to view student progress in <u>PowerSchool.</u>

Events & Cancellations



<u>Website</u>, <u>Facebook</u>, and sometimes <u>YouTube</u>

Events at RLRS or that RLRS is a part of are posted on both the <u>school website</u> and the <u>Facebook page</u>.

Athletic events, school board meetings, and some other events are also live-streamed to <u>YouTube</u> if there is an adequate internet connection to do so. If there isn't an adequate connection, these events are sometimes recorded and uploaded afterward.

The website holds calendars for the <u>school year</u>, <u>athletic events</u>, <u>events</u>, and <u>Foster CTE</u>.

Weather Events or Cancellations

Website, Facebook, and Remind

When an event is cancelled or postponed, parents and guardians are messaged via <u>Remind.</u> Information is also released through a banner on the <u>website</u>, as well as the <u>Facebook page.</u>

Weather cancellations can also be heard on the radio and news stations.

Health Notices

When a health notice is announced, these announcements will be posted on the <u>"News & Announcements" page on</u> the website.

Parents and guardians of students who are impacted also receive emails detailing the announcement as well.
