All interested applicants must be a Rangeley Lakes Region School (RLRS) Senior *Student in Good Standing* during the year for which the annual Scholarship presentation applies, including home schooled students.

Applicants must submit:

1. *Proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution(s) of higher learning and also their stated intention to attend.*
2. *Letter of request, resume, and transcript package per RLRS senior advisor(s) guidelines. Must include student's contact information.*
3. *Application package must include proven history of ALL following student attributes:*
  - i. Community Service*
  - ii. Reputable Character*
  - iii. A Senior year GPA of 3.0 or better (or college admissible GPA)*

- Overall quality of applicant's submission packet will be considered.
- All packets meeting requirements will be evaluated in a confidential, fair review process by a minimum of two RAA Board members.
- All Deadlines imposed by RLRS administration will apply.
- Late or incomplete packets that miss a time deadline or do not contain the stated required documentation *will not* be considered, as that would be unfair to those students who met the deadline and requirements.

Alumni Association Award will be a single payment payable to the selected student upon receipt of documentation proving successful completion of Freshman 1<sup>st</sup> semester and enrollment in 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.

**This scholarships is deferrable but ONLY if the recipient reaches out directly to the awarding committee**
